KOSHARE HOSTEL HOUSE RULES

Welcome to the Koshare Indian Museum! We're delighted that you chose our facility and it is our goal to make your stay as enjoyable as possible. As with any overnight facility, there are some guidelines we ask you to follow. Please review and don't hesitate to see us with concerns.

- Arrival & Check-In:** Upon arrival at the Koshare Indian Museum, the tour leader should check-in with the Trading Post staff and take care of any changes in number or remaining balances for the accommodations.
- Briefing:** On show nights, your group will meet after the show with the overnight staff to discuss sleeping arrangements. On non-show nights, we will schedule that during check-in.
- Sleeping Arrangements:** Remember, we're a hostel, which means you get what you pay for. At \$6.50 a person, you get a unique place to throw down your sleeping bag, a nice, hot shower and free admission to view our renowned Museum of Indian art and artifacts. Groups can sleep in the Round Room, Chiefs' Room or downstairs. **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO SLEEP IN THE GALLERIES.**
- Clean Up:** The Scout rule of "leave no trace" applies here. A walk-through with a leader from each troop will ensure the place is as clean as you found it!
- Cooking:** No cooking inside the building, but Patrol Cooking outside can be done with prior arrangement; there are two rather large charcoal grills for your use.
- Exhibits:** We encourage adult supervision while your Scouts are touring the Museum. **Absolutely no backpacks in the galleries and no food, drinks, sun flower seeds or chewing gum in the galleries and Trading Post at any time! If you break it, you pay for it – no exceptions! No throwing (Frisbees, balls, clothing, etc.) in the building.**
- Temperature: & Light Booth** Our heating and cooling systems are on a State-regulated temperature. Please do not touch the thermostats. The light and sound booth is **off-limits**.
- Showers:** On show nights, showers are available to groups up to 6:00 PM **and** 40 minutes after the show is concluded.
- Luggage:** Your personal luggage is better off in vehicles or our outdoor trailers until after the show. If this is not feasible, advance arrangements should be made with Museum staff.
- Recreation Equipment:** We have plenty of items (soccer balls, footballs, basketballs) that can be checked out for a minimum deposit. Remember, if you lose or break something, you will be asked to reimburse the Museum.
- Photos:** There is **no photography allowed** in the galleries. Photos of the Koshare Indian Dancers can be taken **AFTER** the performance.
- Shopping:** Staff is available in our Trading Post to assist you with your shopping needs prior to the show and 30 minutes after the show has concluded. On non-show nights, the Trading Post is open until 9:00 PM for our overnight visitors.
- Check Out:** **Check out is 7:00 AM.** We clean the Museum between 7:00 AM and 10:00 AM to prepare for the next day's visitors. If you need additional accommodations, please make it known in your reservation form.
